BALLOT QUESTIONS:

Question 1

Shall the Village of Corrales impose an 1/8 if 1 percent increase in the Municipal Infrastructure Gross Receipt Tax pursuant to ordinance duly adopted and Section 7-190-18, NMSA 1978, and pledge the proceeds therefrom to support the issuance of up to \$1,000,000 in revenue bond to acquire, design, construct, reconstruct, rehabilitate, and landscape municipal streets and roads, trails, bikeways, walkways, bridges and associated drainage structures throughout the Village?

Question 2

Shall the Village of Corrales issue up to \$500,000 in general obligation bonds payable from general (ad valorem) taxes to acquire, construct, equip, renovate, and improve public buildings in the Village of Corrales?

Question 3

Shall the Village of Corrales issue up to \$1,500,000 in general obligation bonds payable from general (ad valorem) taxes to acquire, design, construct, equip, renovate, improve and landscape fire and public safety facilities for fire suppression and emergency response, and to acquire vehicles, apparatus and equipment for the fire and police department of the Village of Corrales?

Question 4

Shall the Village of Corrales issue up to \$2,500,000 in general obligation bonds payable from general (ad valorem) taxes for the purpose of acquiring conservation easements or other rights or interests in land for the preservation of farmland, open space, wildlife habitat, and recreational opportunities?
